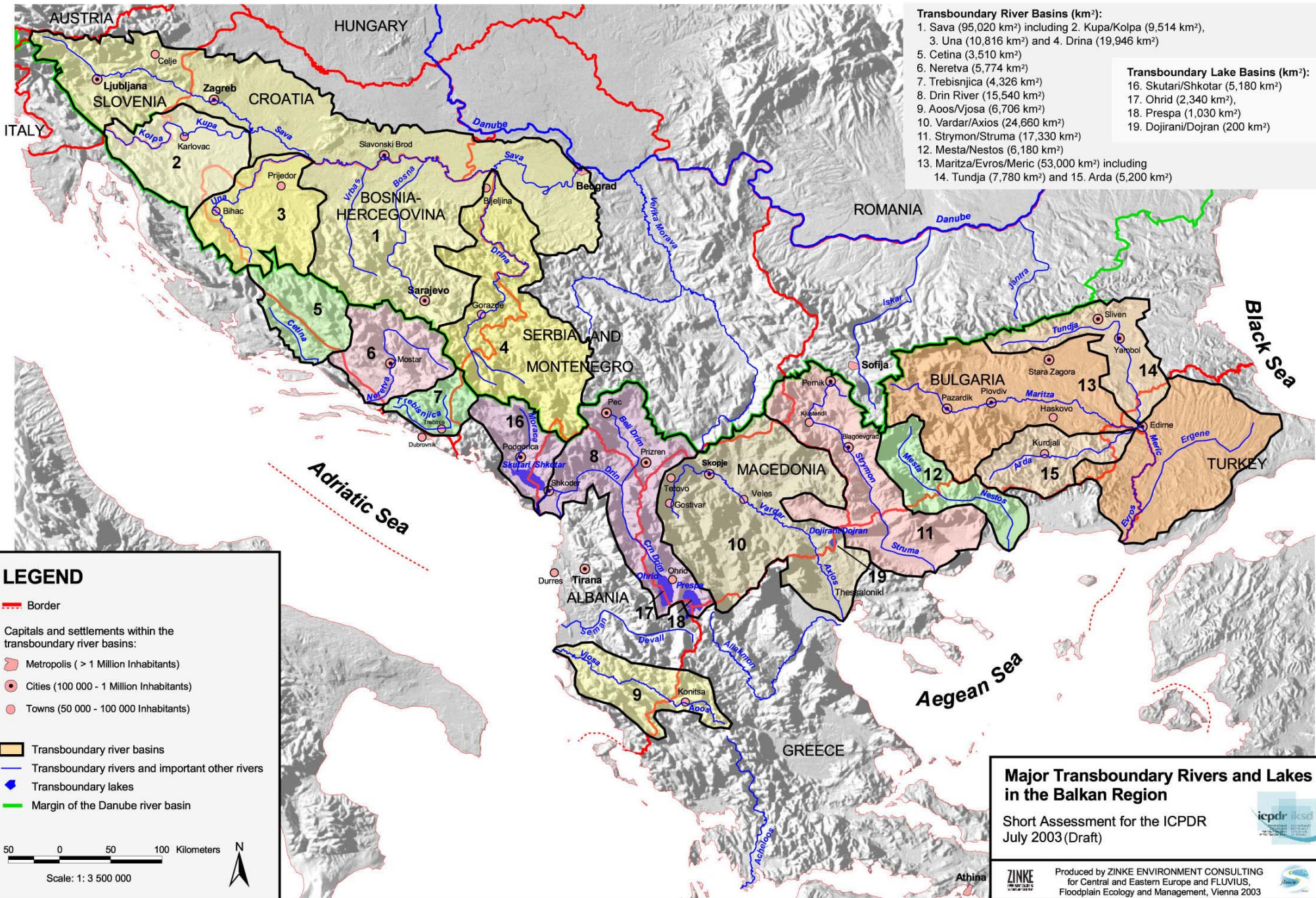


Major Transboundary Rivers and Lakes in the Balkan Region
